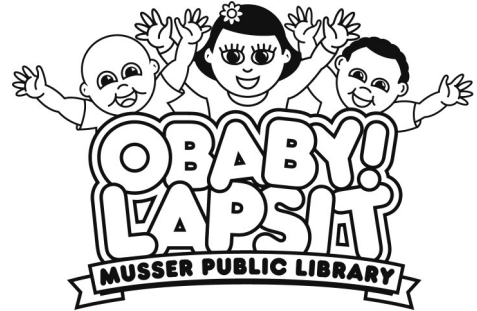

Tues, Dec. 22 at 6:30 pm—Chemical Reactions with the Bluedorn Imaginarium.

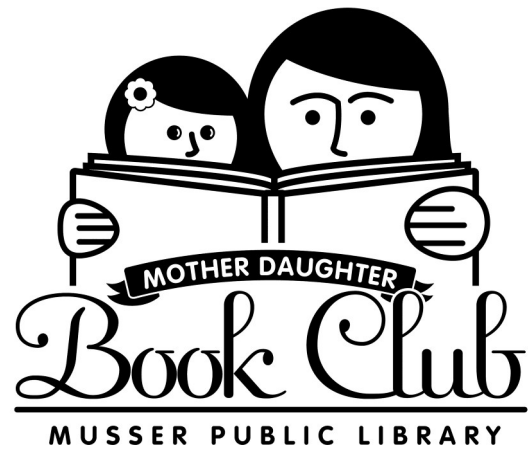
