Supplies

- 2 light blue paper plates or plain plates painted light blue
- Colored paper or construction paper
- Googly eyes
- Handful of Kix cereal
- Colorful Cereal
- Glue

Instructions

1. Cut fish and plants from colorful paper and glue to the blue side of the first plate.
2. Glue cereal to the bottom of the plate, overlapping the plants.
3. Glue fish into place and add googly eyes.
4. Cut the center out of the second paper plate and glue it to the front of the aquarium.

DIY Edible Bracelet

Supplies

- Stretchy beading string the size of your wrist
- Colorful looped cereal

Instructions

1. Cut a piece of stretchy string about the size of your wrist with a little bit to tie it closed
2. Optional: tie a piece of cereal to the end of one side of the string so your pieces don't fall off
- 3: put your colorful cereal pieces onto your string
4. Tie it when you're done
5. Wear and eat!

Cereal Sand Art



Supplies

- Sand Art Bottle
- Small funnel
- Colorful Cereal
- Baggie

Instructions

1. Choose a bottle from the box
2. Separate your cereal by color if you want to
3. Put the cereal in a baggie and use your hand to crush it up into a sand consistency
4. Use the funnel to pour it into your bottle
5. Continue until your bottle is full
