Am I Eligible to Vote?

TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN Connecticut YOU MUST:

- be a United States citizen.
- be a resident of a Connecticut town.
- be at least 17 years old (must turn 18 on or before election day).
- have completed confinement if previously convicted of a felony.




What are the Deadlines for New Voters in CT?

 If registering by <u>mail</u>: your application must be postmarked or received by your Registrar of Voters or a voter registration agency by the 18th day before a primary or election.


 If registering in <u>person</u>: for a general election, you may be able to register and vote in <u>person</u> during the early voting period or <u>on election day through same-day registration</u> at the designated location in your town.
