Am I Eligible to Vote?

TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN Connecticut YOU MUST:

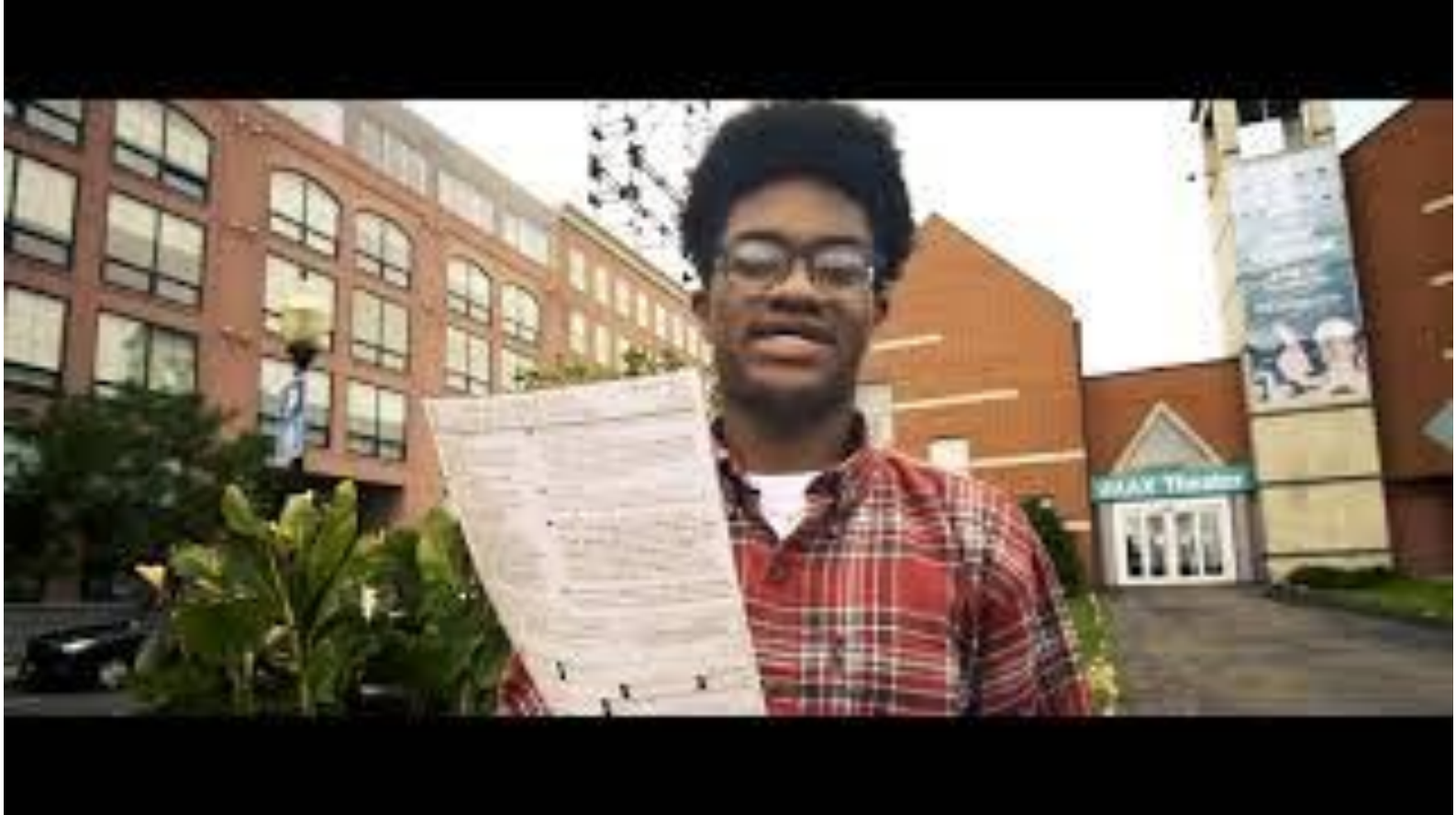
- be a United States citizen.
- be a resident of a Connecticut town.
- be at least 17 years old (must turn 18 on or before election day).
- have completed confinement if previously convicted of a felony.



What are the Deadlines for New Voters in CT?

- **If registering by mail:** your application must be postmarked or received by your Registrar of Voters or a voter registration agency by the **18th day before a primary or election.**
- **If registering in person:** for a **general election**, you may be able to register and vote **in person** during the early voting period or **on election day through same-day registration** at the designated location in your town.

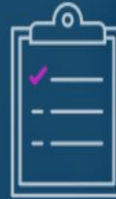
