

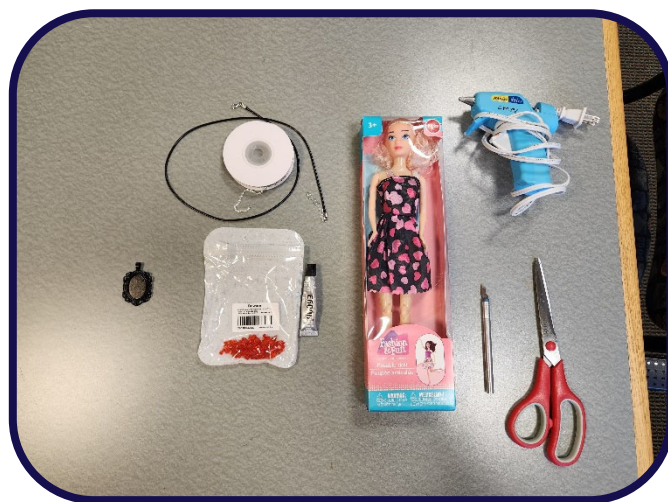


Doll Head Cameo Necklace Handout

For this activity you will need:

- 1 barbie-sized doll
- 1 oval pendant
- 1 necklace chain (24 inches)
- A few loose beads or crystals
- Rhinestone chain
- Scissors
- Pliers
- Glue Gun
- Super Glue
- Craft blade (optional)



Let's get started

1. Pop the head off of your doll. Discard the body.



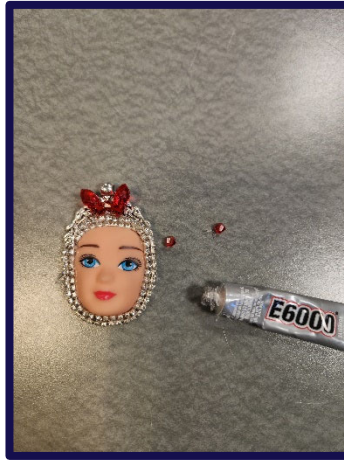
2. Using a pair of scissors, cut around the doll's face. Sever it completely from the rest of the head. You may want to take a craft blade to smooth out the edges. (Alternately, you can make the original cut with your craft blade, but be careful of the very sharp edge!) The doll's face should be cut to fit your chosen pendant, so yours may look different than the instructor's or your neighbor's.



3. Using a hot glue gun, apply glue to the back of the face.
4. Set the face glue-side-down onto the surface of your pendant. Quickly position the face how you want it to look, before the glue dries. Don't worry if there are spots that do not lay exactly flat!

5. Cut a piece of rhinestone chain long enough to wrap around the face.
6. Glue around the outside edge of the face, then place your rhinestone chain on top of the glue.





7. Using super glue, attach a few beads or crystals to the doll's face, to your liking.
8. Feed your necklace through the loop at the top of your pendant. You're all done! (If your chosen pendant does not fit the necklace chain, continue to step 9.)
9. Using pliers, remove the clasp of your necklace chain. Feed your necklace through the loop at the top of your pendant, then re-attach the necklace clasp. You're all done!
